June 22, 2024, marks the 85th foundation day of our party. After Subhash Chandra Bose declared the Forward Bloc as an independent political party in Nagpur on June 22, 1940, the party faced numerous bans and repressions. During this time, we can proudly remember the martyrs who sacrificed their lives to establish, grow, and sustain the party, as well as the leaders who guided the party throughout this period.
